DAY 1 – Monday, September 2 – AIRPORT / OVERNIGHT FLIGHT

Meet at the Kansas City International Airport for your flight to London.

Overnight: International airline flight

**DAY 2 – Tuesday, September 3 – ARRIVE LONDON (L,D)**

Morning arrival at Heathrow Airport in London, England. Once through Customs and Immigration, meet your tour director. Travel to London's city center and take a panoramic driving tour to see all the major sights of both London's Old City and vibrant West End. Drive past such famous sights as Big Ben, Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square, then along the river to the Tower of London.

**DAY 3 – Wednesday, September 4 – LONDON SIGHTSEEING (B)**

This morning's touring begins with a visit to the Tower of London to see the Crown Jewels. Next, visit Westminster Abbey, one of the United Kingdom's most notable religious buildings and the traditional place of coronation and burial site for English, and later, British monarchs. Lastly, visit the Churchill War Rooms, an underground bunker that allowed Britain's leaders to plot the allied route to victory during WWII.

Overnight: The Copthorne Tara, London

**DAY 4 – Thursday, September 5 – LONDON / BLETCHLEY PARK / LONDON (B,L)**

Today, travel to Bletchley Park, the top-secret facility that was home to the team of brilliant code breakers, mathematicians, and spies that ultimately discovered the keys to the German's Enigma Code. On the way back to your hotel in London, visit the Royal Air Force Museum and view more than 95 historic aircrafts on display.

Overnight: The Copthorne Tara, London

**DAY 5 – Friday, September 6 – LONDON / PORTSMOUTH (B,L,D)**

This morning, visit the Imperial War Museum in London to see tanks and aircrafts utilized by British soldiers in WWII before heading south to Portsmouth. Visit the Portsmouth Historic Dockyard and step onboard historic ships and explore magnificent museums from the Royal Navy's past.

**DAY 6 – Saturday, September 7 – PORTSMOUTH / CHERBOURG / SAINTE-MERE-EGLISE / CAEN (B,L)**

Today, cross the English Channel by ferry to Normandy from Portsmouth, England to Cherbourg, France. Travel to Sainte-Mere-Eglise to visit the Airborne Museum and view the iconic church where John Steele and his landing on the steeple are memorialized. Afterwards, travel to Caen and check into your hotel.

Overnight: Best Western Plus Moderne Hotel, Caen

DAY 7 – Sunday, September 8 – CAEN / UTAH BEACH / SAINT-MARIE-DU-MONT / POINTE DU HOC / CAEN (B,L)

Make your way to Utah Beach to visit the [Utah Beach Landing Museum](#). For lunch, stop at the [Roosevelt Café](#), a former fishing house that has since been turned into a café. Proceed to the [Dead Man's Corner Museum](#), the house that the commander of the German 6th Airborne used as his headquarters when D-day started. Next, admire the valor of the Special Forces who scaled a 100-foot cliff to seize German artillery at [Pointe du Hoc](#). Afterwards, return to your hotel.

DAY 8 – Monday, September 9 – CAEN / OMAHA BEACH / NORMANDY CEMETARY / ARROMANCHES / CAEN (B)

This morning, visit [Omaha Beach](#) where the Americans landed and faced the strongest German resistance of the day and incurred the greatest losses. See the [Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial](#) established just two days after the invasion. Then, visit the makeshift port in Arromanches where you can still see remnants of the floating roadways and piers. Afterwards, pay tribute to WWII troops at the [Caen Memorial](#), one of Europe's top history museums.

Day 9 – Tuesday, September 10 – CAEN / PARIS (B,L)

Today, travel to Paris and take a guided driving tour of the city. Take in sensational views of the capital, including the world-famous Louvre Museum and the Arc de Triomphe while learning of the city's rich history.

Day 10 – Wednesday, September 11 – PARIS / (VERSAILLES) / PARIS (B)

Visit [Les Invalides](#), a 17th century veteran hospital turned revolution-era army garrison that is now the final resting place of Napoleon Bonaparte. Visit the [Notre-Dame Cathedral](#) and admire the sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows, and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings. Travel to Versailles for a half-day trip to see the [Palace of Versailles](#) before heading back to your hotel for the night.

Day 11 – Thursday, September 12 – PARIS (B)

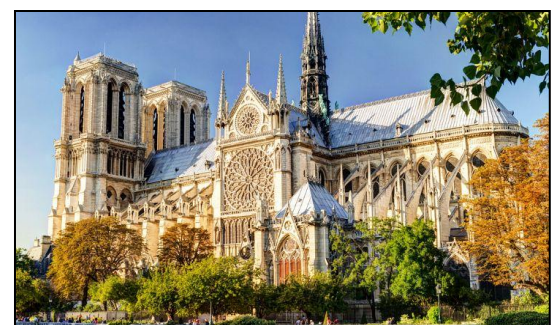
The balance of the day is free for you to explore the city.

Documentation – Tour passengers must carry proof of citizenship with them. For US citizens, this must be a US passport with at least 6 months validity remaining upon return (passport cannot expire before March 13, 2020). Non-US citizens should contact Travel Leaders of Lawrence at (800) 444-4248.

Cancellation – In the event of an individual's cancellation, the following cancellation policy will apply: Any cancellation prior to and including Friday, June 7, 2019, \$100 per person; after Friday, June 7, 2019 up to and including Friday, July 5, 2019, \$1,000 per person; after July 5, 2019 up to the day of departure, cancellation during the travel program or for a "no show," no refunds will be made. Total tour costs are nonrefundable.
